Grant Program: **AKINFO**

Authority: AS 44.29.020 and 7 AAC 70

Priorities: The Division of Health Care Services (HCS) is required by the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Maternal, Child Health Bureau, Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, and the United States Department of Agriculture Women, Infant and Children program to assist families in accessing needed services through establishing and maintaining a toll-free statewide telephone information and referral (I&R) service. The I&R services must be offered 24 hours per day, seven days per week (24/7). This 24 hour I&R line, once referred to as the Healthy Alaskans Information Line, is now part of the AKINFO project which includes 24/7 telephone referral services and an Internet-based database of referral agencies throughout the state.

Target Group or Geographic Region: This grant serves all Alaskans in need of information and referral (I&R) to community health and social service resources in the state. Callers from across the state can use a toll-free number to access information contained in the AKINFO database. Information and referral specialists answering the calls use the database to locate services for individuals in large and small communities.

Resource Allocation: Available funding is awarded to one agency that can provide statewide services.

Criteria: Funds have been awarded as a single source grant because the United Way of Anchorage is the agency that best met the goals and objectives of the project. The United Way is responsible for the AKINFO database and is the proprietor of the database. Furthermore, the United Way of Anchorage is the sole other financial partner in the AKINFO project with HCS contributing approximately half the funding needed to support the project.

Appropriation: Grant funding is appropriated to the Division of Health Care Services, Medical Assistance Administration Component.
